- <u>21-3032 Dyjak v Lynn, et al.</u> Plaintiff Dyjak is a detainee at Packard Mental Health Center. His case proceeds on Plaintiff's failure-to-protect claim against Defendants Jo-an Lynn, Stacey Horstman, and Harvey Daniels. This matter is set for a Final Pretrial Conference on December 17, 2024, at 1:30 p.m., and a Jury Trial on January 21, 2025, at 8:45 a.m.
- <u>21-4195 Williams v Abernathy, et al.</u> Plaintiff Williams is detained at Pinckneyville Correctional. His case proceeds on Plaintiff's unconstitutional conditions of confinement and excessive force.
- <u>22-4114 Blakely v Osmundon, et al.</u> Plaintiff Blakely is detained at Illinois River Correctional Center. Plaintiff's case proceeds on an Eighth Amendment claim for deliberate indifference to his serious medical needs and for retaliation.
- <u>23-1452 Bracey v Jackson, et al.</u> Plaintiff Bracey is detained at Lawrence Correctional Center. He is mentally ill and blind in one eye. Plaintiff's case proceeds on a claim for deliberate indifference towards his serious medical needs.
- <u>23-3253 Laffey v Wagner, et al.</u> Plaintiff Laffey is detained at Graham Correctional Center. Plaintiff's case proceeds on a claim for denial of medical care and failure to treat pain against Defendants Hester, Coleman, Curran, Graham, Boden, Venvertloh, and Doe.
- <u>24-1221 Matlick v Zimmerman, et al.</u> Plaintiff is detained at the Joliet Treatment Center. The Plaintiff suffers from mental illness and says that he cannot litigate the case himself. He has a single claim of excessive force against three Defendants
- <u>24-3130 Olden v Clark, et al.</u> Plaintiff is detained at Illinois River Correctional Center. Plaintiff's case proceeds on an Eighth Amendment claim for deliberate indifference to his serious medical needs.
